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## Village Hall Report – 12<sup>th</sup> October 2016

Bookings for the Village Hall have gone smoothly. We have picked up seven, four hour bookings on a Wednesday evening for a Tango class and Gillian Frost has been in touch about setting up an extra pilates class.

I was contacted about a problem with one of the water boilers which wasn't working, as we have another boiler I have disposed of the broken one. It was reported that the fan in the kitchen wasn't working but GT Electrical checked it and it seemed to be functioning well. The ivy at the back of the store room has grown under the roof and was putting leaves all over the chairs so I have removed it from the back of the hall and cleared up in the store room but ideally the ivy needs removing from the garden fence of the property behind the store room.

Hall users have noticed the following issues: mould growing on the chairs in the store room and it was suggested that we either put background heating in the store room or insulated the walls and roof.

After noticing the dirty windows in the hall Deborah Brady has kindly obtained a quote to have the windows, doors and sills cleaned quarterly at £60 per cleaning.

At the present time we have very limited funds and improvements to both the hall and playground would be welcome but it would require extra funds to become available.
